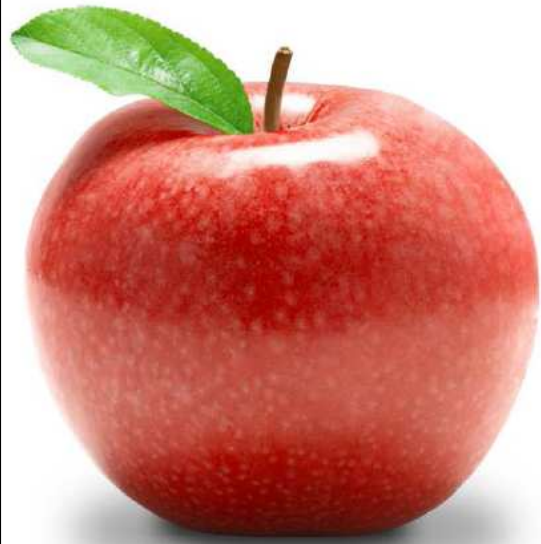

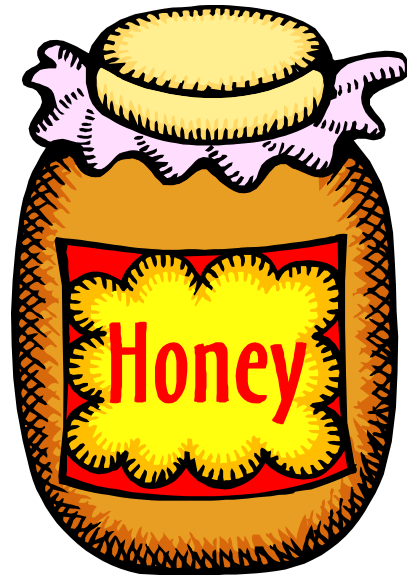

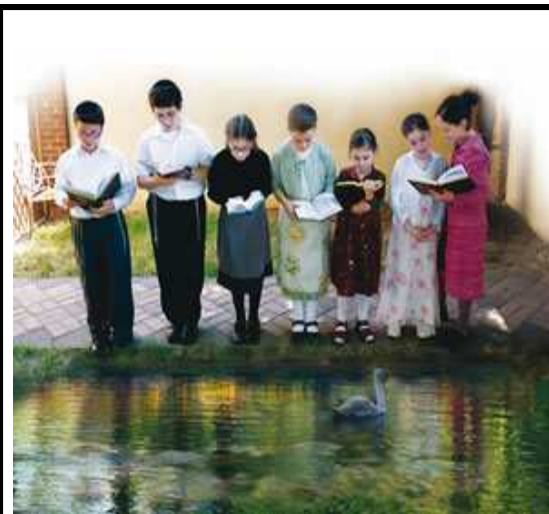

1 c. oil



1 tsp. baking soda



1 tsp. baking powder



1 tsp. cinnamon



2 1/2 c. flour



1 c. strong coffee

Directions:

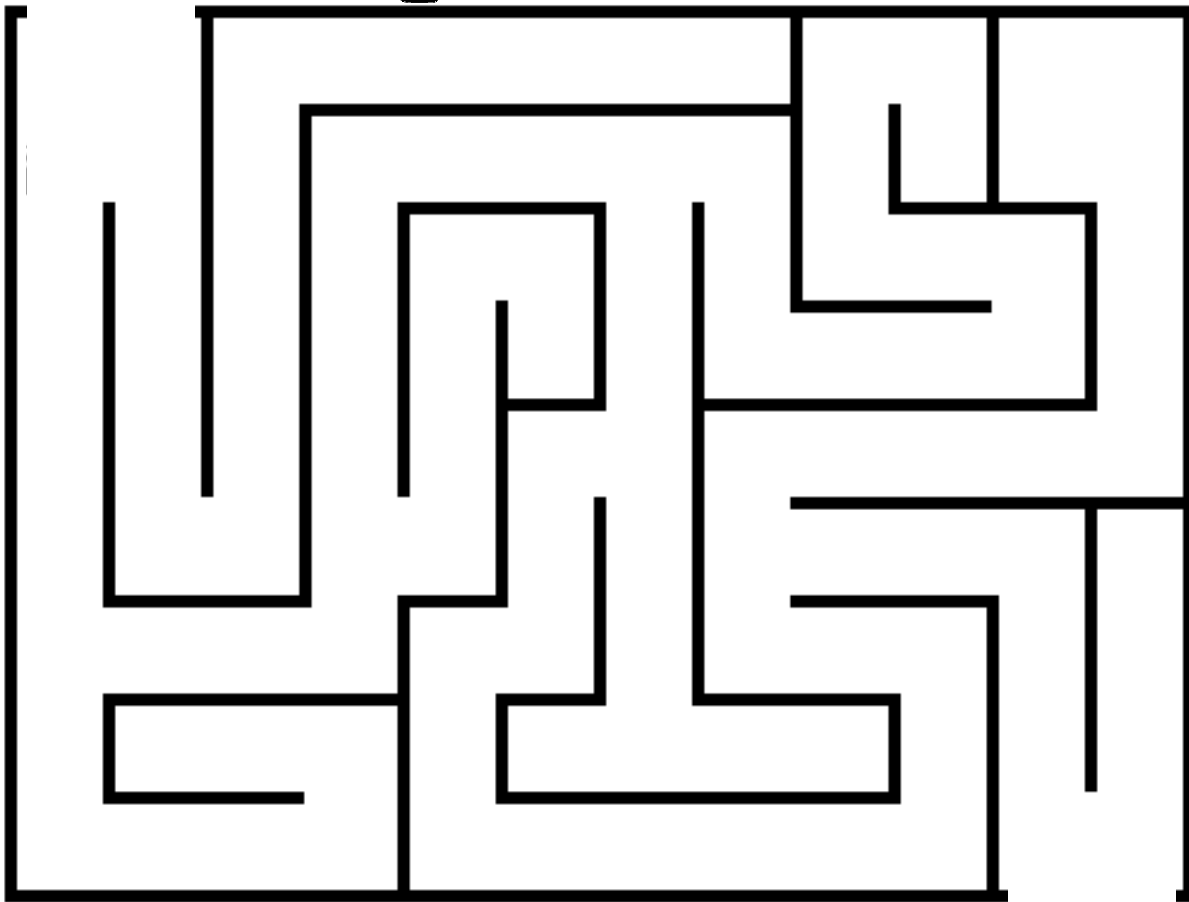
Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Mix all the ingredients together.

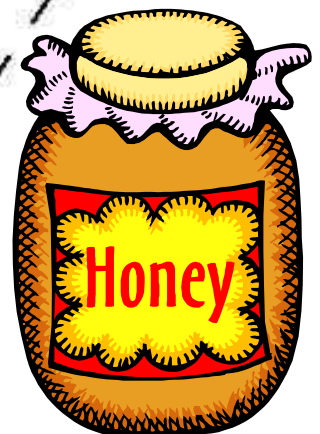
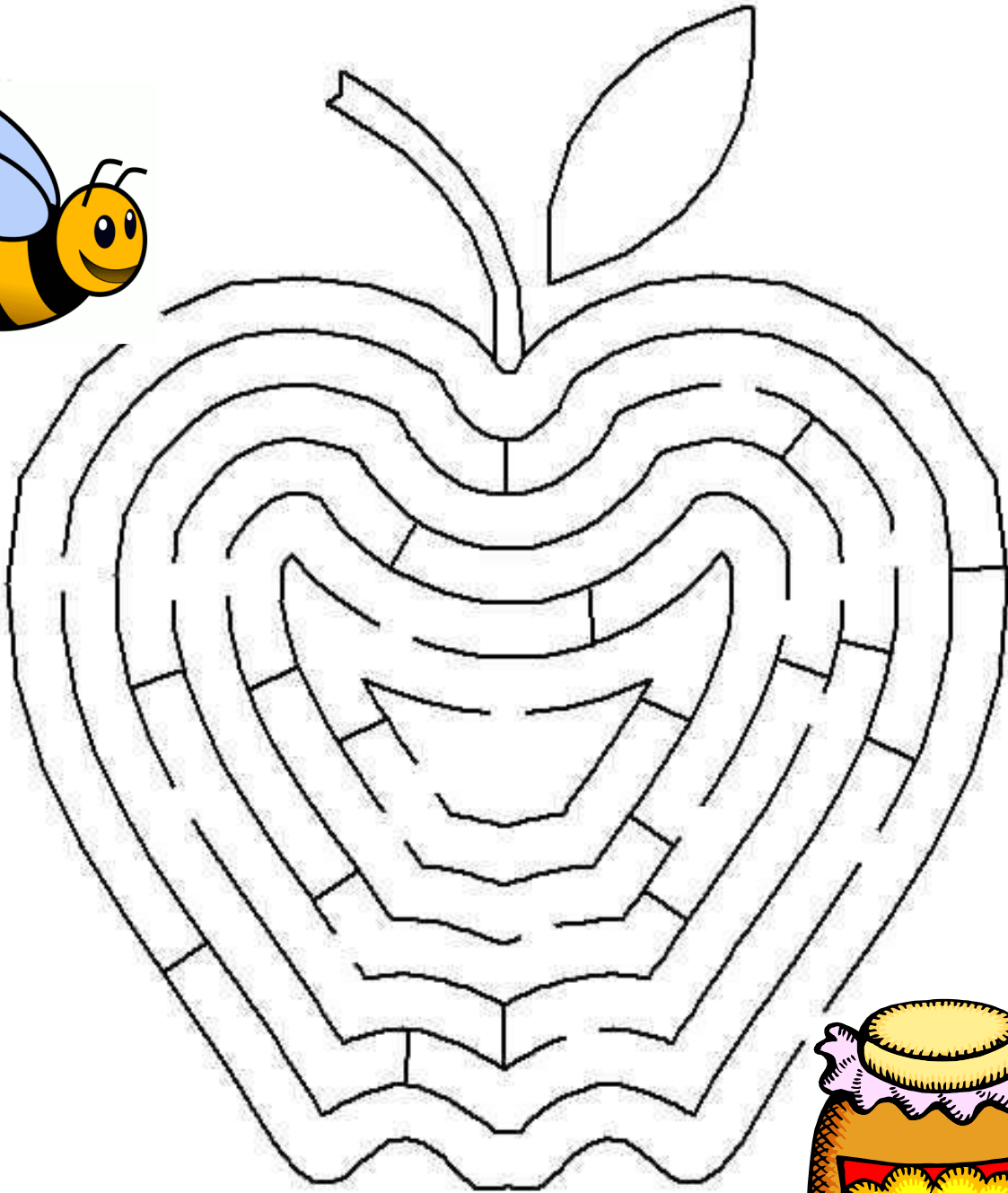
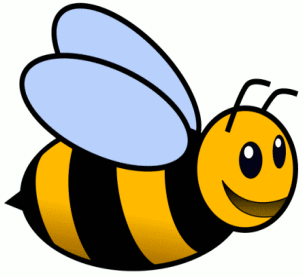
Pour into a greased 9x13 pan.

Bake for one hour or until toothpick inserted comes out clean.

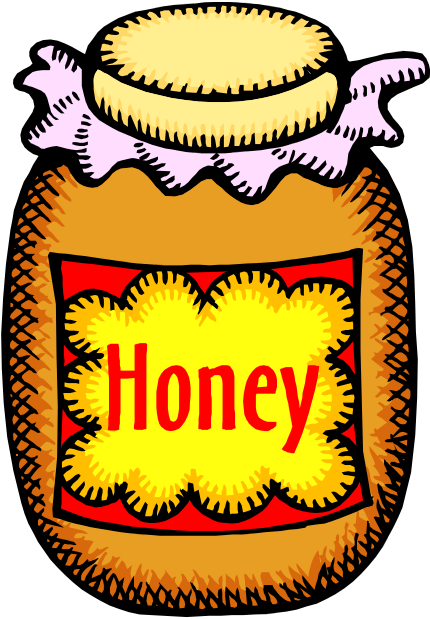

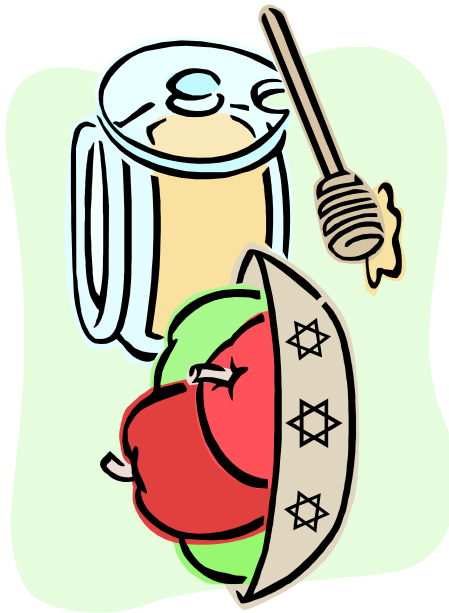
Show the Honey Bee the way to

Clip Art Idea's for Rosh Hashanah:

- Using the different pictures, make a Shana Tova Card for someone
- Make 2 copies of each page on card stock and make a Rosh Hashanah Matching Game
- Cut out each picture and create a Rosh Hashanah Mobile to hang up
- Make a Rosh Hashanah Collage
- Play show and tell with the cards, each child takes a card and describes it, you have to guess what they are describing
- Make corresponding cards to each picture with the first letter of each word and then match them up
- Find the actual objects in your home that match up to each card
